(1) 9½" square

### Sandals

(1) 6½" x 8"

### Straps

(1) 3½" x 4"

### Flower Centers

(2) 3½" squares

### Petals

three yellows  
4" x 10" from each

### Paper back Fusible Interfacing

½ yd

### Buttons

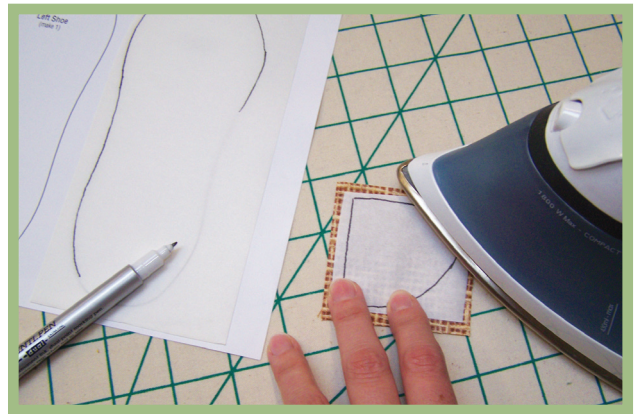

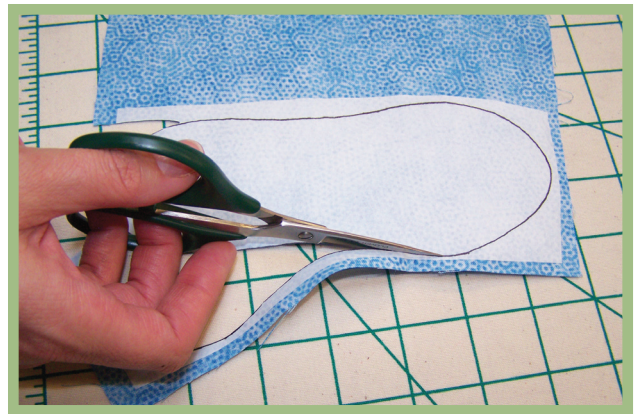

# Making Sandals and Sunflowers

1. Trace shapes onto paper side of interfacing. Rough cut around shapes.
2. Place fabric **wrong side up** on pressing mat. Center rough side of fusible pattern on wrong side of fabric.
3. Fuse in place **for two seconds**. Allow pieces to cool.
4. Using sharp scissors, cut out each shape on the line.

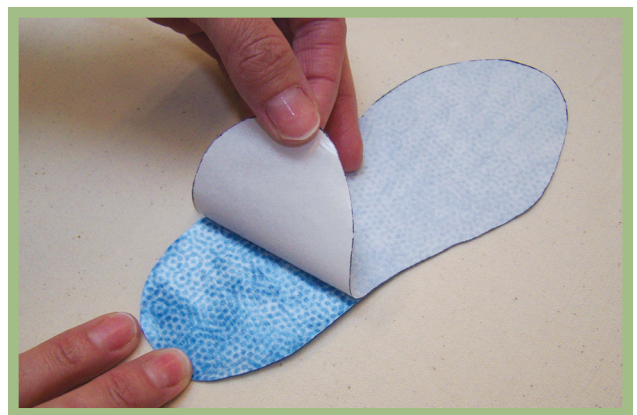


*Center rough side of fusible pattern on wrong side of fabric. Fuse in place for two seconds.*

5. Peel off paper backing by running your fingernail across the edge of the paper, or scratch the paper with a pin.

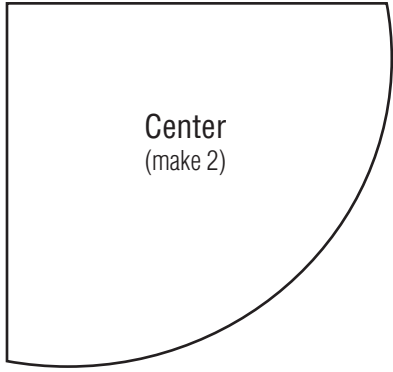


*Peel off paper.*

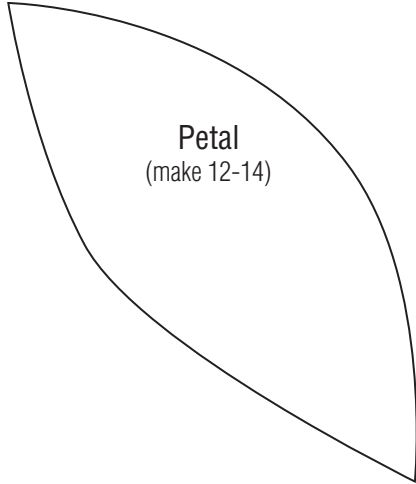
6. Position sandals and sunflowers on 9½" Background square as desired.
7. Carefully overlap appropriate pieces. Fuse pieces in place for 8 - 10 seconds. Layer straps on sandals, fuse in place.
8. Stitch pieces in place with matching thread. Embellish straps with buttons or beads for an artistic finish.



*Fuse pieces in place for 8-10 seconds.*

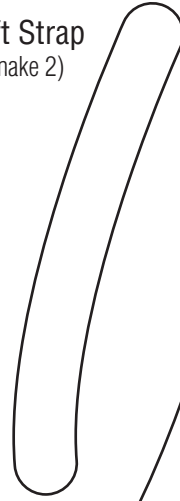


**Center**  
(make 2)

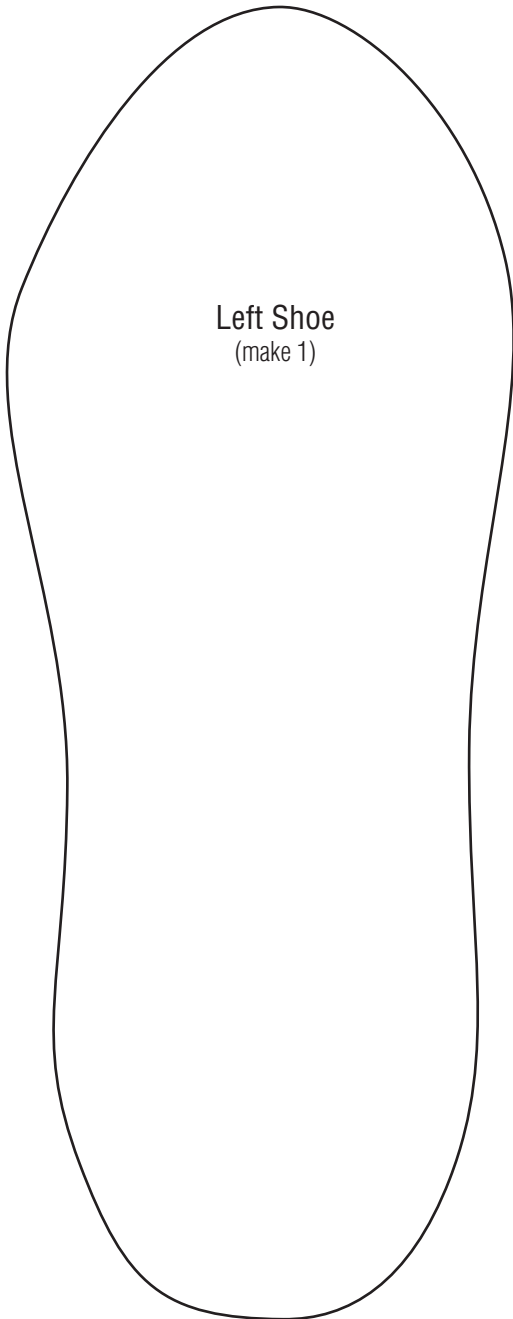


**Petal**  
(make 12-14)

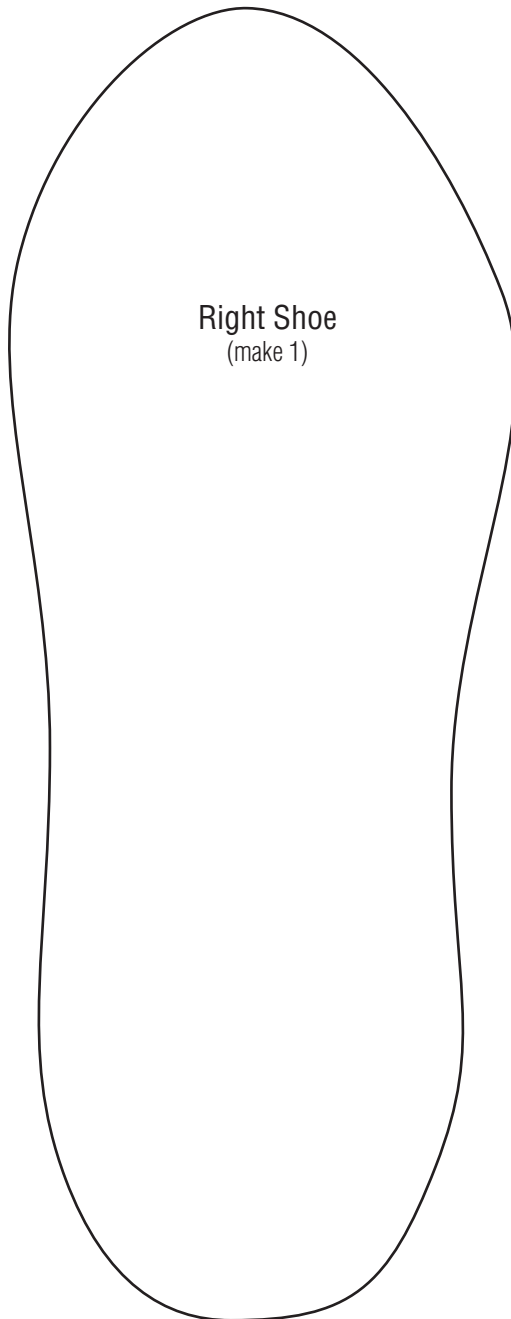
**Left Strap**
